Drove out to skidsteer. Checked and found wiring all corroded. The boom was down and could not get lifted up. Hauled unit into shop. Raised the boom with the hoist. Went through wiring and found supply fuse was corroded off and a diode was corroded off. Installed new fuse and fuse holder. Crimped new ends on wiring. Installed new battery cable. Repaired harness where it was corroded. Installed new pigtail and diode. Used heat shrink to seal up. Found more fuses and holders were corroded. Spliced in new wires and fuses. Cleaned all other fuse holders. Started skidsteer. Ran good, but seat switch would not go off. Removed and installed new seat switch. Started skidsteer and ran good. Customer complained of engine overheat after using. Checked and found the fan blades had turned. Turned fan blades back to correct position. Advise customer fan should be replaced.
